PLAINTIFF’S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXCEED PAGE LIMIT

Plaintiff, GRCO LLC (“Plaintiff”), seeks leave of Court to exceed the page limit imposed by the Court’s Civil Practice Standards, and states the following in support:

1. Under D.C.OLO.LivR 7.1(a), undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for Defendant regarding this motion. Defendant does not object to the page extension.
2. Defendant filed its Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff’s Amended Complaint on July 28, 2023 (the “Motion”). *Docket No. 19.*
3. Plaintiff sought and received an extension to file its response to the Motion to September 1, 2023. *Docket No. 26.*
4. Under Civ. Practice Standards 10.1(c)(1), responsive briefs shall not exceed fifteen (15) pages, not including the cover page, table of contents, signature block or certificate of service.

5. In order to fully brief the matters at issue, Plaintiff request up to an additional five (5) pages (excluding the cover page, table of contents, signature block or certificate of service), for a total of twenty (20) pages for Plaintiff's Response the Motion.

6. Plaintiff has good cause to seek such relief. The Motion seeks dismissal of nine different counts in Plaintiff's complaint, claims that seek declaratory and injunctive relief and damages for various alleged violations of Colorado law, Colorado statute, and the United States Constitution. The Motion challenges different aspects of the nine claims using a variety of legal and factual contentions, which raise complex issues relating to the sufficiency of Plaintiff's constitutional claims, the timeliness of the different claims, the availability of availability of injunctive relief for certain claims, and issues of standing, among others. Plaintiff is seeking additional pages to ensure that it has adequate space to respond to numerous issues raised in the Motion.

7. Plaintiff has not previously sought leave to file an overlength response. A trial date has not been set and no other deadlines will be impacted by this requested five-page extension for the Response.

8. As referenced in the Certificate of Service, Plaintiff's representative has been served with a copy of this motion.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests this Court grant it leave to exceed the page limit by five pages in its Response to the Motion.
